Expressive Vocabulary Development (Semantics)

(at or around):

- 12 months - Two words other than "mama" and "papa"
- 24 months - At least 300 words in speaking vocabulary
- 36 months - Vocabulary of approximately 1000 words
- 48 months - Vocabulary of approximately 1500 words
- 60 months - Vocabulary of approximately 2200 words
