





Example of a progress style map

Process

- Open to all youth ages 0-18 (optional activity)
- Participants get a token/cutout to color + add their name
- Participants can give token to staff to put on the board OR add token to the display themselves (scotch tape is best)
- Patron has the option to come to library and tell staff of their progress and interact with staff and the progression board
- Staff and volunteers can include themselves in the activity and create a FOMO to increase participation
- One fidget toy giveaway prize per person.
- Staff/volunteers to confirm token participation before awarding prize

Display Options

- Create your own custom SL-themed map/board.
- The main points of each map should adhere to SL reading goals.
- The map/chart should have a start/finish line with progress points up to the overall 8 hour/book reading goal (at least).




High-dosage tutoring and low-ratio extended academic support for TK - 8th grade



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
