#### V. Discussion/Action Items

# A. INFORMATIONAL: City of San José Budget Overview (C. Chang)

Deputy Budget Director, Claudia Chang, provided an overview of the City's budget process. The 2023-2024 Adopted City Budget is divided into the Operating Budget and Capital Budget. The funds contributing to these budgets are the General funds, Capital funds, and Special funds.

Most funding comes from the general fund. General fund sources come from property tax, sales tax, utility tax, business tax, overhead reimbursements, fund balance carryover, and other. General funds are used for personal services, non-personal/equipment, City-wide expenses, earmarked reserves and contingency reserves, and other expenses.

The City's budget policies and practices requires the Mayor to deliver a budget message to City Council in March. The message includes the statement of fiscal priorities and investments for the following fiscal year. Investment priorities can include: increasing community safety, reducing unsheltered homelessness, cleaning up our neighborhoods, and attracting investment in jobs and housing.

Following the Mayor's March Budget Message to City Council, City Council holds a public hearing to consider the Mayor's budget message and make any necessary revisions. Then, the City Manager will submit a budget request with the balanced budget to Mayor and Council.

There was no public comment.

The Commission engaged in discussion.

### B. ACTION: Planning for Budget Summit on Sunday, January 21.

The Commission planned on the structure of the Youth Commission Budget Summit. The proposed structure of the Youth Commission Budget Summit is as follows:

- 1. Presentations of different City programs.
- 2. Presentation of the Youth Priorities Survey results.
- 3. Conduct an in-person version of the survey in which participants will be divided in smalls groups to discuss solutions to these youth

priorities. Each group will vote on the top three programs/solutions would like to focus on.

4. Conduct a community-style discussion with invited guests such as the Mayor and Councilmembers.

There was no public comment. The Commission engaged in discussion. On the motion of Commissioner Singh, seconded by Commissioner Lieu, the Commission voted unanimously to approve the Budget Summit Plan.
